## THINGS TO REMEMBER



Chair  
Old shoes  
Camera

Buckle collar when working  
Crate/Exercise pen  
Leash

Dress for the weather  
Shade for your dog  
Water (lots if it's hot)

Dress for the weather — This is an outdoor event and it will be held rain or shine.

Dogs should not be near pen until shortly before their turn so they don't get themselves or the sheep too excited. Please use exercise area and pick up after your dog. Porto-potty provided for the rest of us.

## FARM RULES

1. All dogs must be 6 months of age or older.
2. All dogs must be current on their vaccinations (or titer) and parasite free.
3. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when working.  
**No FLEXI-type leashes PLEASE!**
4. Livestock seriously injured while being worked must be paid for by the participant whose dog was working the livestock at that time.
5. Bitches in season may participate, but they will run last.
6. No Schutzhund trained dogs, please.

**What will I do?** Your dog will be put on a 6-foot soft rope and go in the pen with the Tester, Shannon Wolfe. Shannon will help introduce your dog to the sheep and help him/her do its best. Your dog may need you in there also, and then Shannon will help you work your dog. You will have a blast and a day to remember.

The order in which the dogs run is dependent upon the time your entry is received -- and we also prefer to put 3 similar breeds in a row so you can see how specific breeds work. We change livestock approximately every 3rd dog. It will take about 3-4 hours to work all 25 dogs. It is great fun to watch the dogs "turn on" to the livestock.

## DIRECTIONS



Genoa City, WI is located 9 miles south of Lake Geneva at the WI / IL border. *Do NOT use GPS to find us. It will take you to the wrong address. Please use these Directions.*

**From the North:** Take US Hwy 12 south until Freeway ends; at the stop sign turn right (west) onto Hwy H. Follow Hwy H to the first stop sign, which will be in downtown Genoa City, and turn left onto Hwy B, then keep on Hwy B by turning right at the next stop sign. Continue 1½ miles to farm, which is on your right. Site is on your right; park by small house.

**From the South:** Take US Hwy 12 north until you cross the WI/IL state line. About ¼ mile further Hwy 12 splits off to the right to begin the freeway; Hwy H bears to the left, which will take you into Genoa City. Continue as above.



No food or beverages will be available on site.  
You are welcome to bring your picnic-style snacks or lunch.  
Shade/Rain Tents are allowed on site.

**Entry Agreement and Indemnity**

Handler and Owner agree to assume the risk of any harm arising from the hazards associated with the herding event which include but are not limited to, parking areas, ground conditions, animals, livestock used in the herding event, and other dogs.

Handler and Owner hereby release Shannon Wolfe, Magic's Legacy personnel (employed and/or volunteer staff), and the owners of the site of the event, from any and all liability for any injury, loss or damage, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property which occurs directly or indirectly or associated with the herding event.
